NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a petition has been presented to the High Court by the directors of Irish Life Assurance PLC (the "**Transferor**") seeking the sanction by the High Court pursuant to the Assurance Companies Act 1909, the Insurance Act 1989, and the European Union (Insurance and Reinsurance) Regulations 2015 of a scheme for the transfer of a portfolio of certain life assurance products from the Transferor to Saol Assurance DAC (trading as AIB life) (the "**Transferee**").

Any person who considers themselves entitled to be heard may appear at the hearing of the petition in person at the Four Courts, Dublin 7, remotely by

way of the High Court's virtual courtroom or by way of counsel or solicitor appearing in person or remotely.

Any person who wishes to be heard and intends to so appear, and any person who objects to the scheme but does not intend so to appear, should give notice of such intention or objection and the reasons therefor to Portfolio Transfer Queries, Irish Life, Irish Life Centre, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin 1 or by email to <u>PortfolioTransfer@irishlife.ie</u> no later than 5:00pm GMT on 26 September 2023.
